

BY-LAWS and RESOLUTIONS

1. It was resolved that all contestants in Zone Team eliminations must be registered through a Club in the Zone in which the elimination is being held. (2 August 1975)
2. It was resolved that to be affiliated with the NSWCTA, a Club must first be affiliated with their respective Zone. (12 July 1986)
3. It was resolved that if the Club hosting either State Trap or Skeet Carnival fails to meet the conditions of the signed agreement then they will be penalised all or part of the target remuneration at the discretion of the NSWCTA Executive. (8 November 1986)
4. It was resolved that the State Association provides the overall Championship sashes and badges to all Clubs hosting the State & Commonwealth Championship events. (25 June 1988, amended 22 February 2002)
5. It was resolved that all Zones must send their Meeting Minutes to the State Office. (2 July 1994)
6. It was resolved that the Wagga National Shooting Ground be adopted as the NSW State Shooting Ground. (31 October 1998)
7. It was resolved that Clubs endeavour to avoid event programs from clashing with Zone, State or major events. In the event of a Club requiring to alter or cancel a programmed shoot they shall give sufficient notification so as to minimise inconvenience to shooters. The New South Wales clay Target Association [NSWCTA] must be notified of such changes. The NSWCTA may enforce a change of date to avoid conflict. (26 May 2007)
8. It was resolved that State Championships previously on Roster System now be allocated by the Executive Committee after written applications are received. (27 February 1999)
9. It was resolved that all NSWCTA Policies be attached to the NSWCTA Business Plan. (26 June 1999, amended 22 February 2008)
10. Any member that has been cited or reprimanded or under reprimand by a Club, Zone, NSWCTA or the ACTA for;
 - Breached, failed, acted fraudulently, refused or neglected to comply with a provision of the constitution, the by-laws or any resolution or determination of the executive committee or any committee of the association or any other entity exercising delegated authority.
 - Acted in a manner unbecoming of a member prejudicial to the objects and interests of the association and/or clay target shooting.
 - Brought the association or clay target shooting into disrepute.
 - Any matter relating to drugs in sport which involves a member who or which has or is suspected of having contravened the relevant law relating to drugs in sport.

Shall not be eligible for nomination or be elected or be an executive on the NSWCTA committee. (28 May 2010)
